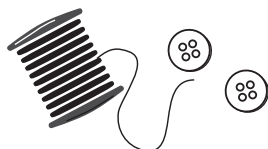

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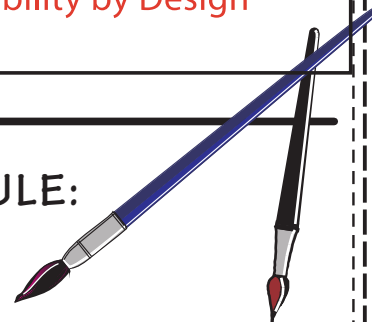

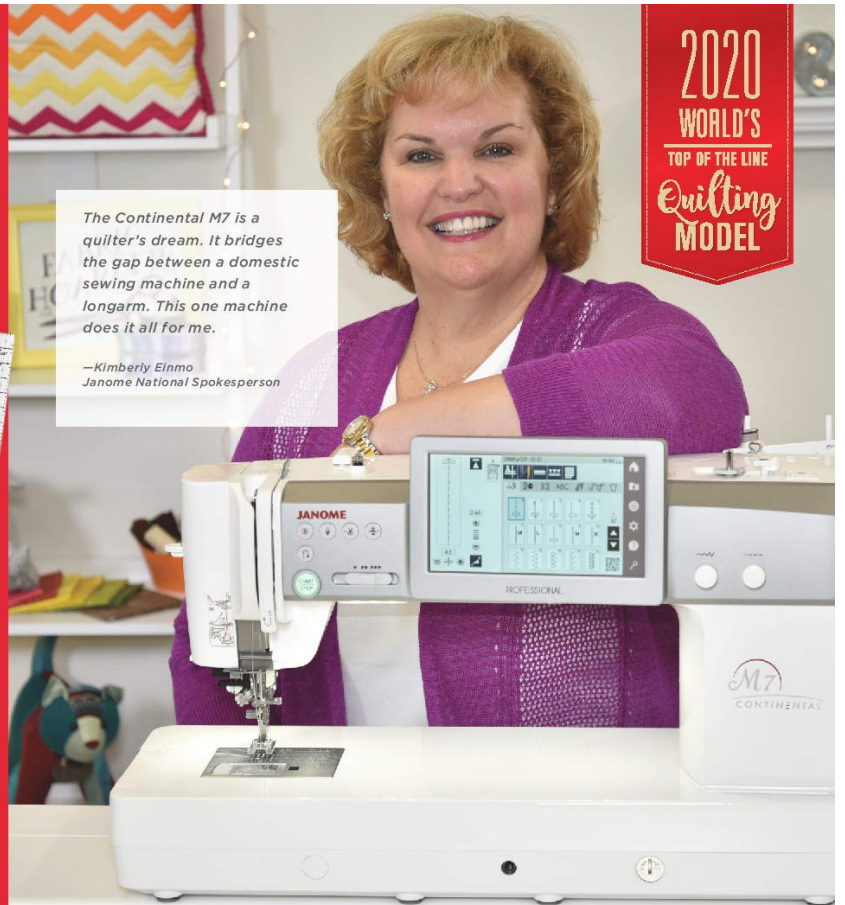
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The Continental M7 is a quilter's dream. It bridges the gap between a domestic sewing machine and a longarm. This one machine does it all for me.
